Life Without the Resurrection

Hugh McKay:

Christians... celebrate 'new life' at Easter, but in a religious sense. The focus of their festival is the belief that tragedy and grief - symbolised by the crucifixion - can give way to new life - symbolised by the resurrection - and that pain and loss are essential steps on the journey towards enlightenment.

So Easter is a festival of hope, a celebration of faith in the future, and a reminder that despite our failures, frailties and flaws, personal resurrection is always a possibility for us.
