11²⁷⁻³³ **"By what Authority...?"**

Jesus says - 'John's baptism – was it from heaven or from men?'

12¹⁻¹² **Jesus tells the Parable of Murderous Vine growers**

'He will come and kill those tenants and give the vineyard to others'

'The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone'

12¹³⁻¹⁷ **Pharisees and Herodians hope to trap Jesus/Taxes to Caesar?**

Jesus says - 'Give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's'

12¹⁸⁻²⁷ **Sadducees seek to ridicule the resurrection** - 'You do not know the

Scriptures or the power of God... you are badly mistaken'

Jesus' last 7 days

12²⁸⁻³⁴ **A scribe (Pharisee) acknowledges Jesus as Teacher**

v32 'Well said, Teacher, the man replied – you're right in saying that God is one and there is no other but him. To love him with all your heart, with all your understanding and strength – and to love your neighbour as yourself is more important than all burnt offering and sacrifices'

12³⁵⁻³⁷ **Jesus exposes the Scribes' ignorance** - 'How can David's son be his lord?'

12³⁷⁻⁴⁰ **Jesus condemns the Scribes** - 'They devour widows houses and for a show make lengthy prayers. Such men will be punished most severely'

12⁴¹⁻⁴⁴ **Jesus observes a widow putting money into the Temple treasury** - 'She, out of her poverty put in everything – all she had to live on'
